Two well meated continental steers from Morgan, Myrtle Hill Farm sold to a top price p/kg of 145.50p/kg for a 720 kilo Limousin and 143.50p/kg for a 780 kilo BB. The 780 kilo BB steer topped at £1119 whilst the 720 kilo Limousin sold at £1047.

CULL COWS & OVERAGE CATTLE (24):

A good entry of non TB tested cows, overage steers and heifers were seen this week being a mixture of good strong continental and dairy cows. The best of the continental cows topped the market at 121p/kg and £915 for a 755 kilo Charolais from Walters, Nantycyw. The best of the Black & White cows peaked at 101p/kg for a 680 kilo Holstein Friesian from Thomas, Cresswell and at £735 for a 740 kilo Holstein Friesian from Davies, Ty Coed. The best of the overage heifers and steers peaked at 127p/kg and £870 for a 685 kilo Charolais from Thomas, Cresswell. Top and leading prices at follows:
