**PRIME LAMBS (445):** With such excellent harvest weather a reduced entry of lambs was seen with trade comparable to last week, which saw the best meated continental types peak at 176p/kg and £75/head. Most of the lambs on offer were those between 39 and 45 kilos, which sold to an overall average of 164.44p/kg and £68.26/head. The overall market average for the day was 163.37p/kg.

Ewes sold to an overall average of £55. Ewes topped at £84 from Davies, South Hill who also sold at £65; with other leading prices at £82 from Morris, Yr Ostrey who also sold at £73; £80 from Phillips, Windsor Farm who also sold at £77 and £65; £79.50 from Davies, TyLlwyd; £79 from Cornock, Cefnydre Farm who also sold at £70, £65 and £60; £67.50 from Bradbury, Trefwynt who also sold at £65; £63 from Thomas, Cildywyll; £62 from Davies & Family Ltd, Parc-Gwyn; £62 from Evans, Lowlands who also sold at £61; £62 from Mathias, Middle Hoaten.

The best of the rams reached £76 from Vaughan, Llysyrawel; with others selling at £74 from Mathias, Middle Hoaten who also sold at £54; £70 from Thomas, Tynewydd Farm who also sold at £60. Wethers peaked at £52 from Thomas, Tynewydd Farm who also sold at £45.50; the same vendor also sold hoggets at £55, £48, and £45.

**CULL COWS & BULLS (15):** An improved entry was seen this week which saw the best meated types peaking at 114p/kg for a 740 kilo BB bull with the best of the cows reaching 105p/kg for an 830 kilo Limousin cow. Topping the day at £870 was the 830 kilo Limousin cow from Harries, Pantyffynnon. The overall average was at 88.66p/kg due to an increased entry of plainer type cows.
