

WHITLAND LIVESTOCK MARKET.
SATURDAY, 17TH JULY - STORE CATTLE SALE.

BARREN COWS: An entry of 25 barren cows sold to a steady trade with a top price of £750 from Thompson, Ysgyborwen with other leading prices at £745 from Beynon, Tir Gil Farm also £735; £715 from James, Upper Porthmawr; £685 from Shepherd, Garnwen; £680 from Beynon, Tir Gil and Evans, Plaschwrt. The overall average was £600 per head, just short of £1.00 per kilo.

STORE CATTLE (258): Another good entry of store cattle saw a particularly fast trade on the best quality steers and heifers with a top price of £875 for 3x Limousins presented by Llewellyn, Wernhyfryd, Llandissilio who also sold 3x Belgian Blues at £850. Heifers sold to a top price of £825 for a Limousin from Harries, Pantyffynnon, Henllan Amgoed with young bulls selling to £600 for a Limousin from Jones, New House Farm. Young bulls averaged £260 with steers averaging £600 and heifers averaging £510.
