**EWES (745):** Another good entry of ewes was seen with the best yearlings still selling well over the £100 mark whilst selling to an average of £104/head. The best of the yearlings peaked at £125 for Suffolk Xs from Miles, Gwili Vale who also sold further Suffolk Xs and Mules at £124, £118 and £116. Other leading yearling prices at £120 for Suffolk Xs from Jones, 20A Dol Y Dderwen who also sold at £100; £118 for Texel Xs from Goodwin, Gwynionllethri who also sold at £115 and £114; £112 from Owen & Davies, Cwmderi; £110 from Reed, Long House; £106 from Davies, Cerrigman Farm who also sold at £105 and £104; £104 from Williams Bros, Penbwlch Isaf; £100 from James, Newton East. The older ewes topped at £110 from Leaney, Cruglas Farm; £94 from Cox, Pantygroes; £91 from Williams, Milestone Farm who also sold at £80; £90 from Miles, Gwili Vale who also sold at £83; £89 from Davies, Treginnis Uchaf who also sold at £82, £73 and £71; £76 from Evans, Panthyfryd; £75 from Bowen, Marsh Farm. A small selection of ewe lambs sold to £58.50 from Williams, Panthwdog; with other reaching £51.50 from Jenkins, Snowberry Cottage.

**RAMS (59):** There were plenty of rams on offer being a mixture of yearling and more mature rams. The days top price of 435gns was paid for a Suffolk yearling from Rees, Kiln Park; with other leading yearling prices at 420gns for a Texel from Jones, Robleston Hall who also sold further Texels at 400gns, 390gns and 370gns; 395gns for a Texel from Monahan, Stember Farm House who also sold further Texels at 380gns, 370gns and 365gns; 360gns for a Suffolk from Reynolds & Lawrence, Garndwyrain; 350gns for a Texel from Davies & Co, Cwmcynon; 315gns for a Texel from Williams, Marchgwyn Uchaf who also sold a further Texel at 310gns; 305gns for a Charollais from Thomas, Clear View; 300gns from Evans & Son, Scurlage Castle Farm; 280gns for a Texel from Wilson & Partners, Common Church; 275gns for Texels from Davies, Morfa Farm. The older rams topped at 365gns for a Texel from Thomas, Gwarllwyn; with other leading prices at 215gns for a Texel from Williams, Marchgwyn; 200gns for a Texel from Jones, Eithinduon Uchaf; 170gns for a Suffolk from Wilson & Partners, Common Church. The best of the ram lambs topped at 370gns for Charollais from Hughes, Bronwydd who also sold further Charollais at 350gns; 240gns for a Suffolk from Reynolds & Lawrence, Garndwyrain.
